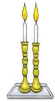


Yahrzeit Reminder

For all congregants requesting a service for a yahrzeit, the office will send out an e-mail with your request to all members of the congregation who have provided their email address. The Rabbi/Ritual Committee will provide an individual to lead the service, provided that you make your request seven (7) days in advance. However, it is up to you to make sure your request is made to the office one week prior to your request date. Most important, you must ask your friends and relatives to attend. We can not guarantee a minyan (10 people) for you. That is your responsibility.

Remember, being a member of a minyan for someone else, will assure you of getting a minyan when you need it.

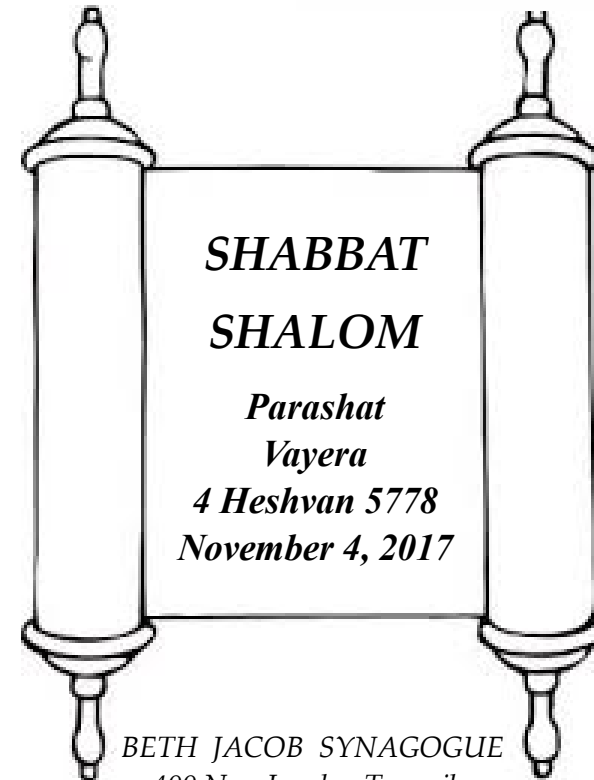
