A Message from your Shabbat Gabbi"

This week we begin year one of the triennial cycle with the Book of Genesis, Parshah Breshit, "In The Beginning". The reading recounts the story of creation in six days. On the first day God made darkness and light. On the second day he formed the heavens, dividing the sky from the earth. On the third day He set the boundaries of land and sea and called forth trees and flowers and grass from the earth. On the fourth He fixed the position of the sun, moon and stars. Fish, birds and reptiles (like snakes and lizards) were created on the fifth day. On the sixth day land animals and then the human being Adam. God ceased work on the seventh day, and sanctified it as a day of rest, it was Shabbat. For those with access to a copy of the Etz Hayim (or any other volume that contains the Five Books of Moses), the triennial reading can be found starting at Chapter 1 at verse 1, Page 3 of the Etz Hayim. The weekly reading concludes on page 12 at the end of verse 3 of Chapter 2.
