A Message from your Shabbat Gabbi"

This week as we continue our journey through the Triennial cycle, we continue reading from the Fourth Book of the Torah, the Book of Numbers with parshah Naso, which means "count". The counting of the Israelites is completed. God tells Moses the Tabernacle duties of the Levite families. God tells Moses the law for the wife who is suspected of being unfaithful. Aron and his descendants are instructed on how to bless the Children of Israel. For those with access to a copy of the Etz Hayim (or any other volume that contains the Five Books of Moses), the triennial reading can be found starting at Verse 21 of Chapter 4 on page 791 of the Etz Hayim. We conclude the weekly reading on page 795 at the end of Verse 10 in Chapter 5.
