### A Message from your Shabbat Gabbi"

This week as we continue our journey through the Triennial cycle, we continue reading from the Fourth Book of the Torah, the Book of Numbers with parshah Korach. The name of the parshah "Korach" refers to Korach, head of the rebellion against Moses and Aaron. Korach stages a rebellion against Moses, challenging his leadership. He and his followers are swallowed up by the earth. The people protest, and a plague follows. Of the staffs submitted by all the tribes, only Aaron's blossoms almonds; proving that he is God's chosen. For those with access to a copy of the Etz Hayim (or any other volume that contains the Five Books of Moses), the triennial reading can be found starting with Chapter 16 Verse 1 on page 860 of the Etz Hayim. We conclude the weekly reading on page 868 at the end of Verse 15 of Chapter 17.
