A Message from your Shabbat Gabbi"

This week as we continue our journey through the Triennial cycle, we continue reading from the Fourth Book of the Torah, the Book of Numbers with parshah Shelach, which means 'send.' Moses sends twelve spies to the land of Canaan to see what the people are like and forty days later they return. All but two spies report that the inhabitants are warriors and more powerful than the Israelites. The Israelites weep that they would rather return to Egypt. For those with access to a copy of the Etz Hayim (or any other volume that contains the Five Books of Moses), the triennial reading can be found starting with Chapter 13 Verse 1 on page 840 of the Etz Hayim. We conclude the weekly reading on page 845 at the end of Verse 7 of Chapter 14.
