A Message from your Shabbat Gabbi"

This Shabbat as we celebrate the Holiday of Sukkot we read from the Third Book of the Torah, The Book of Leviticus. The *parshah* discusses the laws which pertain to *Kohanim* (priests) and the high priests, and the Temple service, then followed by a long discussion of the festivals of the Jewish calendar. For those with access to a copy of the Etz Hayim (or any other volume that contains the Five Books of Moses), the reading can be found starting with Chapter 22 Verse 26 on page 723 of the Etz Hayim. The weekly reading concludes on page 730 at the end of Chapter 23 Verse 44.
